





Founded in 1932, as one of the earliest higher education institutes in south part of China, Guangxi Normal University (GXNU) is a provincial and Ministry of Education owned university in Guangxi Zhuang Autonomous Region, China. With three campuses, covering a total area of 300 hectares, GXNU is comprised of 23 colleges (including one independent college - Lijiang College), and offers degrees to students at the Undergraduate, Graduate, and Doctoral levels.



GXNU offers 35 academic disciplines, covering 12 categories including: philosophy, economics, law, education, literature, history, science, engineering, agriculture, medicine, management, and arts. The university is authorized to set up several additional degrees and positions which include: 3 post-doctoral research mobile stations; to grant Doctoral degrees in 2 first-level disciplines and 12 second-level disciplines; confer Master's degrees in 22 first-level disciplines, 152 second-level disciplines, and 15 specialties; and full-time undergraduate degrees in 72 specialties. To date, the university has received more than 15,000 shortterm and long-term international students from more than 60 countries and regions.




The general student population includes 21,949 undergraduate students, 5,716 graduate students, 122 Ph.D. candidates, over 1,800 international students, and more than 13,000 distance and visiting students. GXNU is also known for having a strong reputation of success and significant influence internationally. It has established cooperative and exchange relations with over 200 universities and institutions of higher learning in more than 40 different countries and regions.





Given the development of university size and rapid internationalisation, the university governance and management is facing challenges. GXNU is eager to cooperate with other Chinese and European universities to enrich knowledge and competence in governance and modernisation of university management.

GXNU will support the gap analysis & optimisation of work






GXNU will

GXNU will support WP3quality assurance and internal peer assessment






GXNU will
