




# RESEARCH RELATED TO ACADEMIC LEADERSHIP AND ACADEMIC LEADERSHIP DEVELOPMENT

Uncovering factors predicting the effectiveness of MOOC-based academic leadership training (Dinh, Zhu, Nguyet, Qi, Journal of Computers in Education, 2022)

- measured the contributing roles of design course factors to the variance on learning effectiveness of MOOC-based leadership programs
- identified the strongest predicting variables to the training effectiveness.

# RESEARCH RELATED TO ACADEMIC LEADERSHIP AND ACADEMIC LEADERSHIP DEVELOPMENT

Cultural Transformation and Academic Leadership: The Context of Turkish Higher Education (Kondakci & Zayim-Kurtay, LEAD Book, 2019)

 explored if transformational leadership is an effective leadership style to to achieve cultural transformation in Turkish HEIs

Transformational changes on Turkish universities imposed

- centralized structural characteristics of Turkish HE system
- different missions into research, teaching, and regional development institutions
- Limitations in the wide application of transformational leadership

Navigating the Covid-19 Turbulence in Higher Education: Evidence from Turkish Faculty Members (Orucu, Kutlugun, REAL, 2022)

 presented the experiences of the academic staff and their views on the HEI leaders during the pandemic

Turkish Academic leaders during pandemic

- The more care and support systems more trust and cohesiveness during pandemic
- Experienced leaders: caring, supportive and collaborative
- Inexperienced leaders: not transparent, high level of control, ambiguous implementations

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# RESEARCH RELATED TO TRANSFORMATION IN HEIS

A case study of decentralization reform in a Chinese university (Liu, Yao & Xue, 2002, AEJO)

- introduced a case of a Chinese university concentrating on decentralization reform

- chance for an equal partner for leading HEIs


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# RESEARCH RELATED TO INTERNATIONAL COOPERATION
